

Fiji is an archipelago of more than 300 islands. It's famous for its rugged landscapes, British colonial architecture and stunning lagoons. The island's friendly people are a mix of Polynesian/Melanesian and Indo-Fijians (South Asian/Indian).

Savusavu is pure paradise. Originally established as a port for trade ships, this Fijian town is now a fast-developing tourist hotspot. From the colorful pearl farms & hot springs to the bustling farmers market where locals chat about the food.

Taveuni is Fiji's "Garden Isle" renowned for its stunning waterfalls, coral reefs and tropical rainforests. Bouma National Heritage Park makes up more than a third of the island and Taveuni also holds the International Date Line marker.

Nuku'Alofa is the capital and largest city of Tonga's 170 islands. It is the cultural center for the people of Tonga and was a stop for Captain Cook on his voyages. The city is home to the historic Royal Palace & Tombs of the Kings of Tonga.

Avatiu settlement on Rarotonga in the Cook Islands is just 20 miles around and is becoming a foodie location with its numerous cafes and artisan organic food scene. With stunning lagoons & Te Rua Manga Peak, this island is a jaw-dropper.

Aitutaki in the Cook Islands is often hailed as the world's most beautiful lagoon. This is a great chance to get into some of the most stunning water in the world or enjoy the views of the palm-fringed coast that looks like magazine cover

Bora Bora is the grand dame of French Polynesia and the Society Islands. This is the place that will remind you of Bali Ha'i, the views are surreal and pure magic. To explore the lagoon of Bora Bora is something to be treasured.

Moorea means "yellow lizard" in Tahitian. Known for its jagged volcanic mountains, Mount Rotui overlooks picturesque Ōpūnōhu Bay. Moorea is a geographical marvel with its eight voluminous peaks that rise from its lagoons.




